- 2. 5% relaxation in attendance – 70% for Theory and 75% Practical instead of 75% Theory & 80% for Practicals (ref. 2<sup>nd</sup> cited) and Promotion to SECOND MBBS (ref. 3<sup>rd</sup> cited)**

**INSTRUCTIONS TO THE STUDENTS**

- All the students of FIRST PROFESSIONAL, SECOND PROFESSIONAL shall abide by the Regulations of Competency Based Curriculum of the Medical Graduate Programme as prescribed by National Medical Commission, New Delhi.
- Passing in FIRST PROFESSIONAL is compulsory before proceeding to PHASE- II training. As prescribed in the Medical Council of India Regulations on Graduate Medical education, 1997, clause 8 passing in First Professional is compulsory before proceeding to Second MBBS training. It is to inform all the students that unless the students pass successfully in the First MBBS examination they will not be promoted to Second MBBS.**  
Moreover, if a candidate has failed to pass in the supplementary examination he/she will have to repeat the 1<sup>st</sup> MBBS course curriculum and appear for the University examination of 1<sup>st</sup> MBBS with the new batch.
- For 2019 Admitted Batch onwards, no more than four attempts shall be allowed for the candidate to pass FIRST PROFESSIONAL examinations. The total period for successful completion of first Professional course shall not exceed four (4) years. Partial attendance of examination in any subject shall be counted as an attempt. A learner shall not be entitled to Graduate later than ten (10) years of her/his joining the first MBBS course.**
- A learner, who fails in the SECOND PROFESSIONAL examination, shall not be allowed to appear in Third Professional Part-I examination unless she/he passes all subjects of second Professional examination.
- All the students have to pay Marks memo fee along with the Examination Fee.



**GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO THE PRINCIPALS AND STUDENTS**

**(Read all the Instructions carefully)**

1. **Digital Valuation of MBBS Theory Answer Scripts is being implemented from July/August, 2017 Examination onwards.** For further details College Principals, faculty and students concerned are requested to refer University Circular dated 27/07/2019 which is also available on the University website  
[http://ntruhs.ap.nic.in/notification/Exam Notification/digital evaluation.pdf](http://ntruhs.ap.nic.in/notification/Exam%20Notification/digital%20evaluation.pdf)
2. Internal Assessment and Attendance particulars of all exam going students duly signed by Head of the Department and countersigned by the Principal along with scanned CD should be sent, so as to reach the University Office on or before the last date.
3. **The Internal Assessment Marks and attendance once sent to this office shall be final and no changes will be entertained later. Hence, HODs and Principals are requested to verify the correctness while uploading ONLINE or bubbling the OMR Sheets as the case may be, before authorizing and forwarding the same to University Office.**
4. Internal Assessment marks of previous examinations will not be considered.
5. The student is not eligible to appear for the University exam if he/she does not appear for Internal assessment exams or if the Internal assessment exam marks & attendance percentage are not received in this Office on or before the last date prescribed in the Notification. In such case the candidate will be detained and no changes will be entertained later on.
6. **One time relaxation is given to First MBBS 2020 admitted batch only, for the eligibility criteria to appear in University Examinations with regard to:**
  1. Internal Assessment Marks – 40% instead of 50%
  2. 5% relaxation in attendance – 70% for Theory and 75% Practicals instead of 75% Theory & 80% for Practicals
7. **All the Candidates appearing for Second Professional shall have attended at least 75% of the total number of classes in theory and 80% in Practical/Clinical, jointly to become eligible to appear for the examination in that subject/subjects as prescribed by NMC/Dr.NTR UHS.**
8. **The Internal Assessment Marks received after the last date will not be considered for declaration of result for which the Principal is solely held responsible.**
9. The Principal should verify all the filled application forms eligibility of students and submit to the Controller of Examinations on or before the specified dates. The Principal will be held solely responsible if any ineligible candidates are permitted to write examination.
10. The Principals of concerned colleges are requested to furnish the detailed information and remarks in respect of the candidates who filed writ Petition in the Court regarding their admissions etc, if any. **(THE CANDIDATES WHOSE ADMISSIONS ARE NOT APPROVED WILL NOT BE ISSUED HALL TICKETS AND WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO APPEAR FOR THE EXAMS).**



11. The Principals are advised to form a Committee with concerned Heads of Departments under Chairmanship of Principal/Vice-Principal who shall be responsible for forwarding examination applications and releasing hall tickets as per eligibility.
12. The Colleges should not collect Examination Fee from the Ineligible candidates such as who have failed in IA marks and who have shortage of attendance as per the Dr.NTR UHS/NMC Rules.
13. **The Colleges are instructed to have their own last dates at college level so as to strictly ensure that the Internal Assessment & Attendance, NRDF Forms, Provisional List of eligible candidates along with Examination fee reach the University office on or before the last date prescribed in the University Notification.**
14. Competency Based Under Graduate Curriculum to be implemented from August, 2019 i.e., MBBS batch admitted in first year. Batches admitted and studying currently in MBBS shall continue with the existing Curriculum.
15. Standard Operating Procedure(SOP) for prevention & control of COVID19 pandemic as announced by the Government of Andhra Pradesh from time to time including Social Distancing has to be strictly adhered by all the Examination Centers during the conduct of examinations.
